Questions:

1. What were the main causes of WWI? How were they causes? What were the long term causes and what were the short term causes? Which of the causes played the largest role in the start of the war?
2. What were the conditions like in the trenches during WWI? Why were trenches used? How was war viewed by society at the time? How did those views change over time?
3. What was women's role in WWI? How did they benefit? What happened after the war ended?
4. How did the war end? What were the results of the Treaty of Versailles? What happened to the major countries after WWI? How did WWI play/contribute directly to WWII?
5. What was going on in Mexico before the outbreak of the Mexican Revolution? What events in Mexican history were central to the build up of the revolution? How did the revolution begin?
6. Who were the key figures in the Mexican Revolution? What were their goals for Mexico? What change did they or did they not produce? What happened to Mexico after the Revolution?
